An innovative course on the concept of Peace at the University of Parma

The University of Parma has received a funding from the European Commission to start a **Jean Monnet Module** on the broad concept of **peace**, which will be investigated both domestically (the development and evolution of the welfare state in Europe) and internationally (the promotion of peace and democracy as a goal of EU foreign policy).

The course (B4PEACE: The Challenges to the European Peace) has been included as an optional teaching (8ECTS, 48 hours) in the Political Science Programme for the 2nd semester. This multidisciplinary activity involves economists, sociologists, jurists and political scientists from the University of Parma and from other prestigious Italian universities (Catholic University, Milan Statale, Trento and Turin). Attending Students will have the opportunity to discuss current political issues (conflicts, migration, human rights, social cohesion policies) with experts from different fields.
